Important Notes Regarding Retirees: A person cannot be a retiree AND a full-time officer.

- If a retired is rehired into a full-time position, which is permissible, they must be converted from a retiree to a full-time officer or support staff.
- For those people who are over 72 and drawing their pension because of the old IRS rules which allowed it, they should NOT be retired, because they are in fact working, but accessing their pensions.
- A retired Officer of Instruction or Officer of Research may only return as a casual with the prior approval of the Office of the Provost or the Office of Faculty Affairs.
